He transforms the doll into a Nutcracker.












He goes downstairs to his Emporium of Sweets and Delights.

Clara watches the suffragettes talk and is fascinated.
















gang sneak around the crowd. Grimsewer's

The Prince invites Clara to sit in the sleigh.










The sleigh flies away and Isolde waves goodbye
















Act Two, Scene Eight











Clara and the Nutcracker Prince travel through the moonlit sky.








Winter becomes summer.
